The Navy League cadets will be paired up with either a Sea or Air cadet and will be asked to offer poppies for a donation at various locations around Newmarket. Any parent who could assist with drop off and pick up of the cadets should complete that section of the permission form below.

There will be no meeting at the Optimist Hall on the Thursday night.

Both nights are part of the “2-2-8 Participation Campaign”. Participation in the Thursday Poppy Campaign is one of the “2” mandatory dates and participation in the Friday Poppy Campaign is part of the “2” of 3 parade dates. Participation moves a cadet closer a free camp session later in the year, but, more importantly, the veterans have requested a good turnout.

Parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their cadet(s) at the Legion Hall at the designated times.

The permission form must be submitted before taking part in the event.
